The New Port Richey Outpatient Clinic opened in 1985 as a community-based clinic and then later transitioned to a satellite-based clinic to serve the needs of veterans in West Pasco County. Practicing primary care through a team concept, the demand for services increased dramatically through the years. In May 2000, the clinic relocated to a larger facility in New Port Richey and serves veterans in Pasco, Hernando and Citrus counties.

PRIMARY CARE SERVICES

The purpose and objective of primary care is to provide a holistic approach to veterans through a coordinated interdisciplinary team, as well as to improve access to outpatient services and referral to other levels of care in an efficient, high-quality and cost-effective manner. There are currently four primary care teams. Each team is comprised of physicians, mid-level practitioners, nurses and administrative support personnel. Two social workers and one dietitian support all four primary care teams.
