

# Polytrauma Transitional Rehabilitation Program

## Just the Facts.....

In Fiscal Year 2015:

30: Number of participants treated in the program

73%: Percentage of participants with traumatic brain injuries (TBI)

10%: Percentage of participants with anoxic brain injuries (ABI)

17%: Percentage of participants with cerebral vascular accidents (CVA)

28: Number of Male Participants

2: Number of Female Participants

**Active Duty** Military treated in the program during FY 15 (8)

**Veterans** treated in the program during FY 15 (22)

144 days: Average length of stay per participant

5: Average number of treatment hours / Day

37: Average age of participant (Age range: 22 – 64)

72%: Percentage of participants that met their target goal at discharge

90%: Percentage of participants overall satisfied with the program at discharge

Living arrangements at discharge: **Based on 22 discharges (FY 15)**

- 82% Discharged to the community (private residence)
- 10% Discharged to Warrior Transition Unit / Military Barracks
- 8% Discharged to Long term care treatment facility (adult home)

6 months post Discharge: **Based on discharge follow up survey responses (FY 15)**

64% = program participants that were currently **driving**
